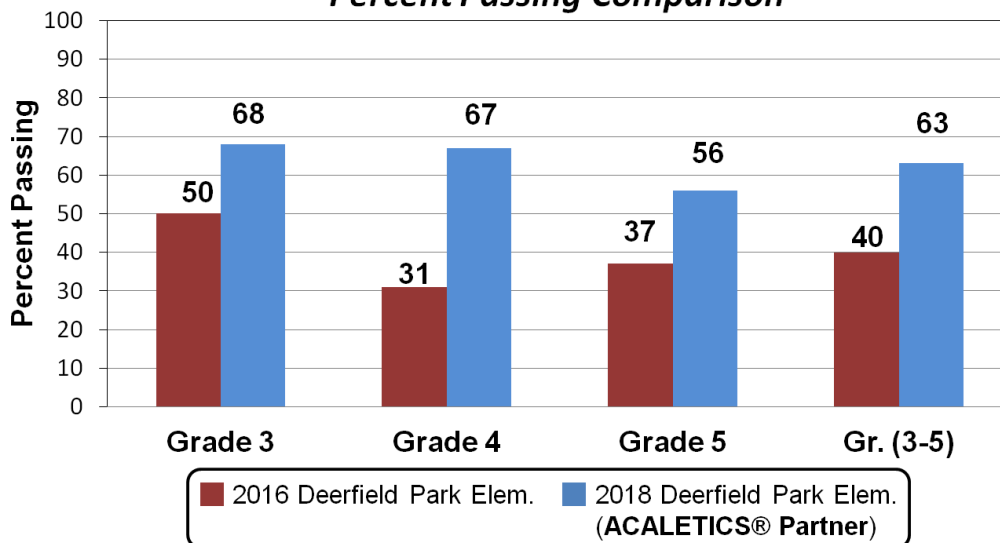

Highlights

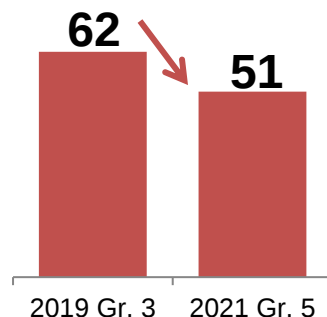
